A C Cossor & Son (Surgical) Ltd is committed to driving out acts of modern-day slavery from within its own business and that from within its supply chains. The Company acknowledges responsibility to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency within the organization and with suppliers of goods and services to the organization.

Our organization manufactures assembles, packs and delivers medical equipment, and in particular blood pressure measuring devices to its customers. Within the supply of these devices there are relationships with external businesses for the sourcing of materials and components. These as well as the suppliers of services make up the supply chains with A C Cossor & Son (Surgical) Ltd.

As part of the Company's due diligence processes into slavery and human trafficking the supplier approval process will incorporate a review of the controls undertaken by the supplier. Imported materials produced from outside the United Kingdom are potentially more at risk for slavery/human trafficking issues. The level of management control required for these sources will be continually monitored.

The Company will not support or deal with any business knowingly involved in slavery or human trafficking.

The Company Directors and Senior Management shall take the responsibility for implementing this policy statement and its objectives and shall provide adequate resources, and investment to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place within the organization or within its supply chains.

This policy statement will be subject to ongoing review.
